

James David Fadden Sr. *Student Athlete* Scholarship Application

The Fadden Family is proud to announce the opportunity for Senior Student Athletes to apply for a \$500 Scholarship. The scholarship is to be awarded at graduation and the recipient will receive the \$500.00 at the beginning of the second semester of his/her first year of higher education OR upon first duty station assignment after successful completion of any United States Military basic training, and technical training school. (Air Force, Army, Navy, Marine, or Coast Guard). The recipient will be responsible for sending a written request to the Fadden Family to include first semester college transcripts or if serving in the military, a copy of first duty station assignment orders.

Scholarship Criteria:

- The applicant must have participated in team sports at South Royalton High School
- The applicant must have demonstrated good character/conduct as an athlete and student
- The scholarship must be used to further academic training in an institution offering one of the following: Technical Training Certificates of any kind to include Military, Associates Degree or Bachelor's Degree
- The applicant must provide two Letters of Recommendation from teachers, coaches and/or underclassman **at a minimum, one Letter of Recommendation must be from a Teacher or Coach.
- The applicant must submit a high school transcript
- The applicant must "add" James Fadden Memorial Softball on Facebook and provide written consent to share members name/photo upon selection as the Scholarship recipient
- The applicant must answer questions 1-6 below and one of the three essay questions
- **Applicant documents must be Submitted to the Guidance Office no later than NOON June 7, 2019.**

Please include the following:

- 2 Letters of recommendation
- Transcript
- Answers to questions 1-6
- Essay (250 words or less)

Please answer the following questions:

- 1) Tell us about yourself; include your name and address?
- 2) What extra-curricular activities have you been involved in during high school?
- 3) Where do you see yourself in 10 years?
- 4) Would you recommend any of your classmates for this scholarship? Who/why?
- 5) Do you think volunteerism is important?
- 6) What College, institution or Military Branch do you plan to attend/join and why?

Please answer one or more of the following questions in 250 words or less:

- 1) If you could change one thing about high school, what would it be and why?
- 2) What was the biggest challenge you have had to overcome in life?
- 3) Who or what has made a significant impact on your life?
