Announcement of Scholarship Program

The Cone Automatic Machine Company Charitable Foundation scholarship program will continue for the coming year. The available scholarships for 2019-2020 are as follows:

- One (1) \$6,000 scholarship to be awarded to a student attending a four year undergraduate program resulting in the equivalent of a Bachelor Degree, to be apportioned at \$1,500 per year commencing with the second semester of the 2019-2020 school year.
- One (1) \$4,000 scholarship to be awarded to a student attending a four year undergraduate program resulting in the equivalent of a Bachelor Degree, to be apportioned at \$1,000 per year commencing with the second semester of the 2019-2020 school year.
- Four (4) \$1,500 scholarships to be awarded at the start of the second semester of the 2019-2020 school year to four students attending either a four year or two year undergraduate program. These are "one time" scholarships to be awarded in 2019-2020 school year only.

Eligibility requirements, selection rules and guidelines, terms of award payment, and applications are enclosed.

All applications must be returned to **Cone Automatic Machine Company Charitable Foundation, P.O. Box 65, Claremont, NH 03743, postmarked no later than May 10, 2019.** Scholarship awards will be announced in June 2019.

Note: The Trustees reserve the right to disburse any unclaimed scholarship funds in the form of additional scholarships or grants to local (New England area) colleges, universities, or other educational institutions.

Scholarship Program Eligibility Requirements

To be considered for an award of a Cone Automatic Machine Company Charitable Foundation Scholarship, a student must:

- A. Be the daughter, son, or grandchild of a former employee of Cone-Blanchard Machine Company having a minimum of five (5) years of continuous service with Cone-Blanchard Machine Company, Windsor, VT.
- B. Be a graduate from an accredited high school, and entering the freshman class at a college or university.

Exception: Recipients of “one time” scholarships will be considered eligible for any “one time” scholarships offered in subsequent years based on reapplication for same.

- C. Be admitted to a four year degree program resulting in the equivalent of a Bachelor Degree or a two year degree program resulting in the equivalent of an Associate Degree.

Selection Rules and Guidelines

1. The Trustees of the Cone Automatic Machine Company Charitable Foundation will select scholarship recipients. The decisions of the Trustees are final.
2. The following criteria will be utilized as part of the selection process.
 - a. Rank in high school graduating class.
 - b. Leadership qualities and school involvement.
 - c. Applicant's written statement requesting consideration for a scholarship award.
 - d. Recommendation by high school principal, guidance counselor or teacher.
 - e. Scholastic Aptitude (or equivalent) Test Score.

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Terms of Award Payment

1. **All checks will be made payable to the college or university in which the scholarship recipient is enrolled, and will be sent directly to the college or university.**
2. **“One time” scholarship payments will be made at the start of the second semester during the first year of enrollment contingent upon the receipt, by the Cone Foundation, of the first semester final grades showing that all academic subjects, (as set forth by the college or university) have been successfully completed.***
3. **First year payment for multi-year scholarships will be made at the start of the second semester contingent upon the receipt, by the Cone Foundation, of the first semester final grades showing that all academic subjects, (as set forth by the college or university) have been successfully completed.***
4. **Successive year payments for multi-year scholarships will be made at the start of the respective school year contingent upon the receipt, by the Cone Foundation, of the final grades showing that all academic subjects for the previous year (as set forth by the college or university) have been successfully completed. ***
5. **Noncompliance with any of the foregoing stipulations or contingencies shall cause the scholarship award to become null and void.**
6. **The Trustees reserve the right to disburse any unclaimed or unused funds in the form of scholarships or grants to:**
 - a. **Other eligible applicants for the same scholarship period.**
 - b. **Local (New England area) colleges, universities, or other educational institutions.**

***NOTE: “Final grades” should be mailed to the Cone Automatic Machine Company Charitable Foundation, P.O. Box 65, Claremont, NH 03743 as soon as available. Checks are requested from the Foundation’s bank, and turnaround time is two/four weeks.**
